Major Responsibilities:

- To operate medical simulation equipment / technologies during training courses or other activities
- To organize supplies and equipment for Centre's use
- To offer professional support to course organizers such as advice on scenario settings for training courses
- To assist in skills training, debriefing, quality assurance, research studies and training development for the Centres' courses
- To deliver training to healthcare professionals / Centre staff / interns on clinical skills and other relevant knowledge
- To serve and support committee work of the Centre
- To administer the Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) applications of activities held at the Academy and maintain its accreditation status
- To perform other appropriate duties as assigned by the Academy

Requirements:

- Holder of Bachelor's degree in related clinical fields
- Qualified / licensed Registered Nurse, with compliance of Continuing Nursing Education requirements set out by the Nursing Council of Hong Kong
- Over 3 years' solid and extensive course or event coordination experience in healthcare sector
- Experience in handling CNE or Continuing Medical Education, quality assurance procedures will be an advantage
- Good IT / computer knowledge and skills with training experience in e-Learning environment a plus
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Good team-player and capable to be multi-tasking
- Able to work on Saturdays / Sundays / public holidays / evenings frequently
